1. Matt ran through the plans for the Christmas Social Evening that followed the committee meeting.

2. Planning.

- Goodsyrd – the committee reviewed the letter sent by Paul on behalf of the group objecting to the Goodsyrd development.
- Blossom St – Charles provided an update on talks between the developers and several interested local groups including SCG. These talks are on-going and there is still a considerable distance between the two parties. A planning application is expected soon, possibly before Christmas.
- It was agreed that SCG should hold at least 2 public meetings each year to allow members the chance of raise concerns about planning issues, or indeed any other local matter. The group should also ensure that there is full communication between the committee and the members on such issues.
