1. Planning. Charles reported on the revised plans for the Norton Folgate development. While welcome, the amendments fail to address the vast majority of the concerns raised by SCG in its objection to LBTH. Charles proposed that a draft letter of objection is sent to members for comments before being sent to the GLA before the deadline of 14th December. Everyone present agreed with this course of action. It was noted that Jon Shapiro, by email, preferred that we withdraw our objection at this point.
2. Licensing. Selina reported on a meeting Jon had held with John Biggs to raise the issue of the lack of implementation of the CIZ by the Licensing Sub Committee.
3. Filming. Peter reported that the recent large film-shoot on Princelet St had passed without incident. A donation is expected.
4. Survey. Matt presented a draft version of the Quality of Life survey and asked for comments. Amendments to the wording and minor changes to the questions were suggested. Matt to put the survey on Survey Monkey and to forward to members.
